## XXX405 & XXX406 CAPSTONE PROJECT I & II

This is a two sequential semesters final year student project work (divided into Project I & II)

The goal is to prepare the students (individuals or as team members) to participate in practical projects related to their respective degree programme subject area, Thus, all students/teams are to follow standard research practice and methods.

Students (as individuals or team members) must carryout their final year project to completion, examining real world constraints, following applicable industrial and business standards.

Such constraints may include but are not limited to: technical, economic, environmental, industrial standards, team time/resource management and cross-disciplinary result integration.

Students are encouraged to work in teams that include collaborative work, but may work on individual projects, provided there is a collaboration component.

Before a student/team can embark on a specific project, final year student project proposal will be written, presented, reviewed and approved at the beginning of the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester.

All students following approved guidelines will participate in a public oral presentation of their project proposal at the beginning of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and will attend a viva-voce to present the final outputs of the project at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

Students/Teams will also submit a written progress of work report at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and a final project report at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

Both reports as well as the oral presentation and the final viva-voce will be graded.
